# **Secretary's Report**: (Jen Voegtli)

March minutes were reviewed. Karen Castelli made a motion to approve. BJ Noonan seconded. Minutes passed.

# President's report (Karen Castelli):

- -We would like to set up a table at the AAFA show for volunteering for the PTO for next year. We did get some people to sign up at the Parent/Teacher conferences, but more volunteers are needed.
- -All PTO Board positions will be voted on in June. We will have descriptions of each position for the May meeting, and anyone interested should send their nomination a week before the June meeting.
- -Next year the PTO Bylaws will need to be revised (2023).
- -We will have a budget meeting in May after the May PTO meeting.
- -We will do a combined Staff/Teacher appreciation day luncheon on Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- -We would like to do weekly gift card raffle drawings for the staff. 2 staff members names will be pulled out of a basket to receive a \$25 gift card. Karen made a motion to put a budget cap of \$400 for the gift cards. Jen Voegtli made a motion to approve. BJ Noonan seconded. The motion approved.
- -The Memorial Day celebration will be held on May 27<sup>th</sup>. We will have veterans coming in to talk to the kids, and a flag folding ceremony will take place.
- -Going forward, we will post a draft of the minutes and budget for online viewers.

# <u>Treasurer's Report</u> (Karen Castelli):

- -Our income last month was \$130 from Amazon Smiles and \$480 from corporate matches for the Color Run.
- -Our expenses last month included \$2430 for Cultural Arts performances, \$104 for the IS Valentine's Day celebrations, and \$54 for the IS recess equipment.
- -We currently have \$42,617 in the bank.

# HKMS Principal's Report (Dolores Bates):

- -The MS had The Music Man performances in person on March 25-26. There was a great turnout and the performances were fantastic.
- -Spring clubs and sports have begun. Tryouts are this week; practice starts next week for sports.
- -Students participated as global citizens by showing support for Ukraine. 6<sup>th</sup> graders sold bracelets and made \$400. The MS will hold a medical supplies drive on April 9<sup>th</sup> from 9am-2pm @HKIMS. Students will collect donations, sort them and box them up for transport.
- -Next Thursday is the last day to buy tickets for the Yard Goats game on May 7<sup>th</sup>.
- -The MS will host a Variety Show. Auditions will be held after April break.
- -8<sup>th</sup> grade stepping up ceremony information will be coming out next week. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade picnic will be held on June 17<sup>th</sup>.
