New Business

- By-laws to be approved at March meeting; most changes were suggested by Grammarly; added wording about removing an officer, added section about remote meetings; added dissolution section; added revision log; BJ will clarify that 2/3 of the executive board will be required to transact business at an executive board meeting; Nicole H. made a motion to accept these changes and vote to approve the revised By-laws at March meeting, seconded by Joyce W.
- Request for funds from Leanne Honious and Paige Callahan for Read across America prizes; most of the Scholastic Dollars that the PTO donated to the school have been used to purchase books for the program and some will be used to give books as prizes; Jen V. can add a line item in the budget for Read Across America and similar requests that will be recurring should be discussed during summer months; there are ample funds in savings to cover the expense this year; BJ made a motion to approve \$641 expenditure and to add a line item to the budget, seconded by Joyce W.
